I. General Regulations

¹These regulations explain the principles and regulations for research activities at SWISS TCM UNI.

² The research regulations are based on the mission statement and the statute of SWISS TCM UNI. It is binding for all persons involved in research.

³ Additional information on research can be found in the Research Regulations and the Research Concept.

II Research and Teaching in the Service of Integrative Medicine

¹The core tasks of SWISS TCM UNI are research and teaching at university level in the field of TCM.

² As an open-minded educational and research institute, SWISS TCM UNI promotes integrative medicine through the interaction of complementary and conventional medicine as well as teaching, research and services.

³ With a wide range of scientific services based on the latest research, SWISS TCM UNI serves the well-being of people. In doing so, it fulfils the requirements under the aspect of effectiveness, economic efficiency and expediency.

⁴ The aim is to offer holistic medicine for the health challenges of our time and to train the specialists and junior staff required for this purpose.

⁵ The freedom of research and teaching is guaranteed.

III Teaching and Research Location Switzerland

¹ The SWISS TCM UNI is located in the traditional Swiss healing and health resort Bad Zurzach, Canton Aargau.

² The SWISS TCM UNI is part of the initiative of the municipality of Bad Zurzach to develop into an internationally distinguished training, research and congress location.

³ The SWISS TCM UNI works closely with national and international universities and institutes as well as renowned experts in teaching, research, service and quality.

IV. Principles of the research work

§4.1 Scientific Independence

¹ The research at SWISS TCM UNI is free of instructions and economically, scientifically and politically independent.

² SWISS TCM UNI excludes any instrumentalization by third parties or by scientists themselves.

³ It refrains from any bias or partiality.

⁴ Researchers represent their scientific position and acknowledge all aspects essential to it.

⁵ Research activities carried out under the name of SWISS TCM UNI must be approved by the university management.



§4.2 Ethics

¹ The research activities of SWISS TCM UNI comply with the scientific, ethical and legal requirements as well as the internationally recognized principles of "Good Clinical and Good Epidemiological Practice (GCP/GEP)".

² Binding ethical standards apply to all research activities: scientific integrity, transparency, sustainability, and gender equality of researchers.

³ For clinical trials, in addition, the investigator must have the required training or experience in good clinical trial practice.

§4.3 Research Culture

¹ SWISS TCM UNI offers an attractive working and development environment for inter- and transdisciplinary work. There are official national and international training and research partnerships.

² Trust and respect, freedom of thought and the joy of jointly developing innovative medical solutions form the basis of the research culture.

³ Research is focused on tangible added value to solve medical, economic and societal problems.

⁴ At the same time, research activities serve the continuous further qualification of all scientific researchers, in particular young scientists.

§4.4 Publicity

Research results are made available to the public, except for research activities with confidential content.

V. Funding

¹ The research activities of SWISS TCM UNI are carried out in financial independence without conflicts of interest.

² Research shall be financed from the operating results of SWISS TCM UNI or by third-party funds.

³ Any additional fund received shall be made transparent in publications. Exceptions may be approved by the university management if there are justified confidentiality interests.

⁴ Further provisions are regulated in the Regulations on Support.

VI Evaluation and utilization

¹ Each research project shall be evaluated with regard to its significance, impact and yield within a reasonable period of time after project completion.

² The evaluation serves, on the one hand, to assure quality and, on the other hand, to utilize findings for future research work.



VII Final Regulations
